### Sports Leaders UK Young Leader Award

The Sports Leaders UK Young Leader Award offers leadership training for young people aged nine to 13. This award bridges the transition from primary to secondary school and teaches leadership skills through a range of games and activities. The award responds to the individual needs of each organisation and its Young Leaders through a flexible and varied programme.

The Sports Leaders UK Tutor Resource Pack enables anyone to deliver training for the Young Leader Award. Tutors must guide Young Leaders through the 'learning by doing' process of the award.

The Young Leader Award encourages learners to take early responsibility for themselves and their peers. Schools use the award to support the delivery of National Curriculum at Key Stages 2 and 3 across a range of subjects, including PE, English, Citizenship and PHSE.

More than 40,000 young people gain Young Leader Awards every year. Organisations do not have to become an Approved Assessment Centre to deliver this award, and are supplied with a Tutor Resource Pack, a CD-ROM with downloadable resources, and certificates for Young Leaders on completion of the award.
