Sports Leaders UK Level 2 Award in Community Sports Volunteering

Following on from the Level 1 Award in Sports Volunteering, this qualification is aimed at learners aged 16 and over and is designed to develop generic sports volunteering skills.

The learner does not have to be good at sport, and will be assessed on their understanding and ability to carry out a volunteer role within a sporting and/or recreational activity.

While training, learners will only volunteer under direct supervision; once qualified, however, they will be able to volunteer under indirect supervision. Learners must complete 10 hours of volunteering to complete their qualification, which takes place at the end of the course. This volunteering experience will take place outside the Approved Assessment Centre.

In order for learners to complete the Level 2 Award in Community Sports Volunteering, they must gain a First Aid certificate and a National Governing Body award in officiating.

Once qualified, a Level 2 Community Sports Volunteer is qualified to assist with the running of small events, festivals or fundraisers under indirect supervision.
