Sports Leaders UK Level 2 Award in Dance Leadership

Anyone aged 16 and over can take the Sports Leaders UK Level 2 Award in Dance Leadership – regardless of their own performance ability.

Designed to develop generic leadership skills that can be applied to a variety of dance situations as well as contributing to the personal development of the learner, this is a practical qualification in which learners must demonstrate the ability to lead in simple dance activities. The aim of this qualification is to give learners a breadth of knowledge to be able to become effective leaders. The learner will not be assessed on their ability to perform, therefore technical aptitude of the learner is not paramount to the completion of the qualification.

The qualification consists of seven units of work which add up to an approximate total of 58 hours of learning time. In addition, in order to complete the qualification, the learner must also complete 10 hours demonstration of leadership at the end of the course.

In order for learners to complete the Level 2 Award in Dance Leadership, they must also gain a First Aid certificate.
